EXTENSION ACTIVITY

Imagine you are a travel director in 1915. You have to plan trips for two groups of adults who want to travel from the East Coast to the West Coast. One group wants to avoid states that allow alcohol. The other group wants to avoid states that prohibit alcohol. Plan both cross-country trips by showing the routes and states you would suggest for each group.
