

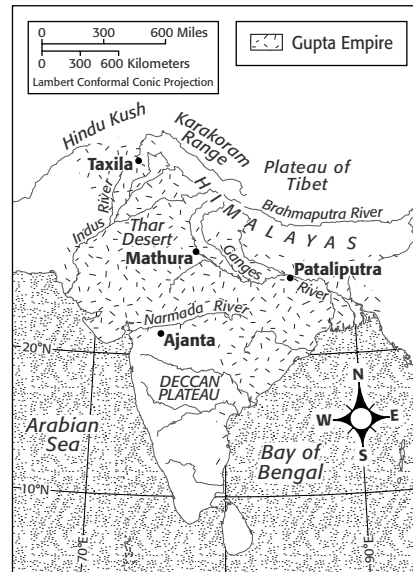
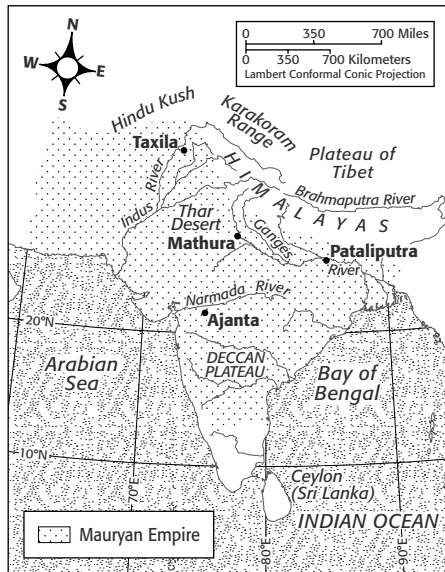
Comparing Maps

LEARN THE SKILL

Individual maps provide important factual information about an area. However, by comparing two maps, it is sometimes possible to draw new conclusions about an area.
